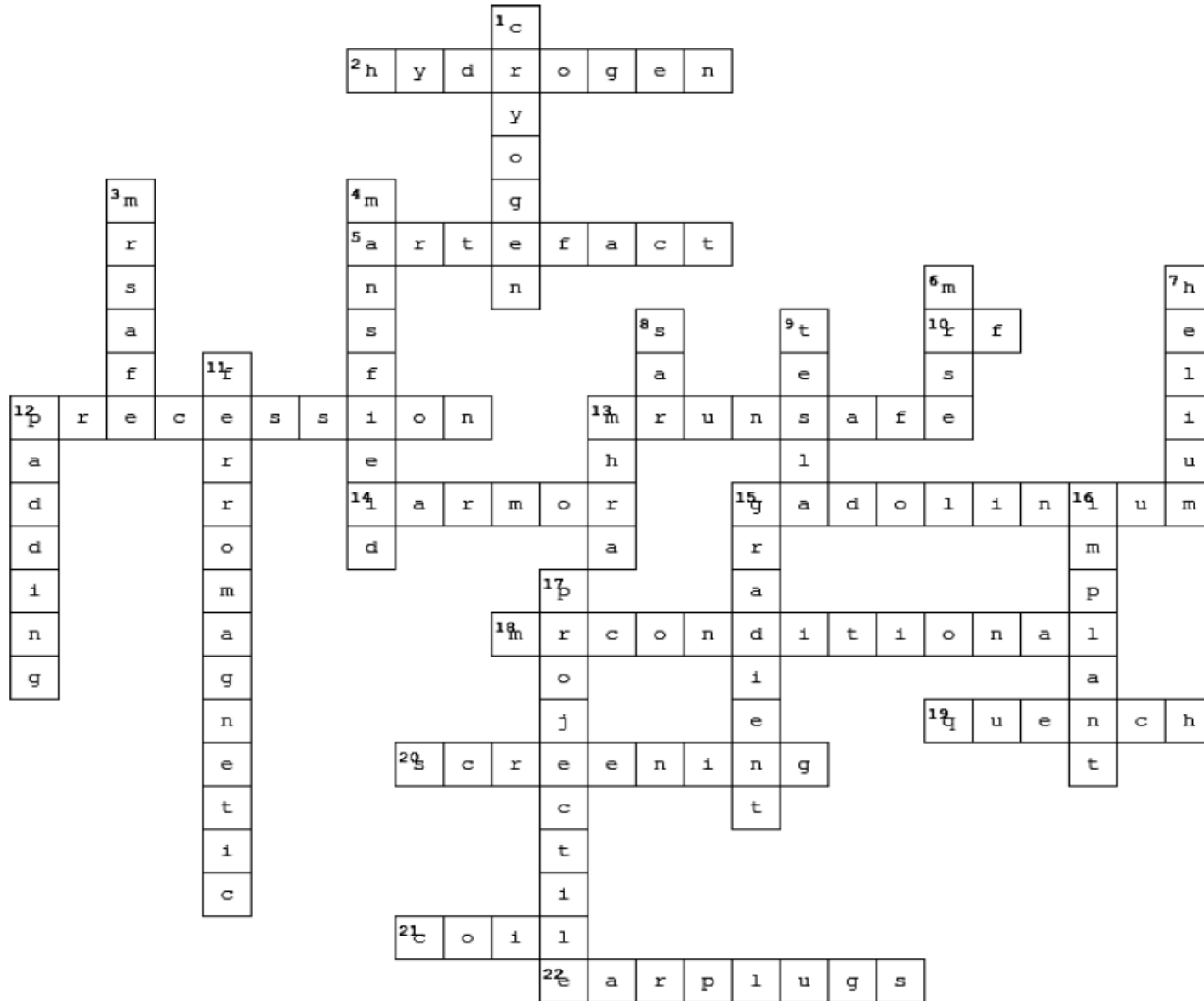


What has BAMRRR focused on for MRI Safety Week 2026?

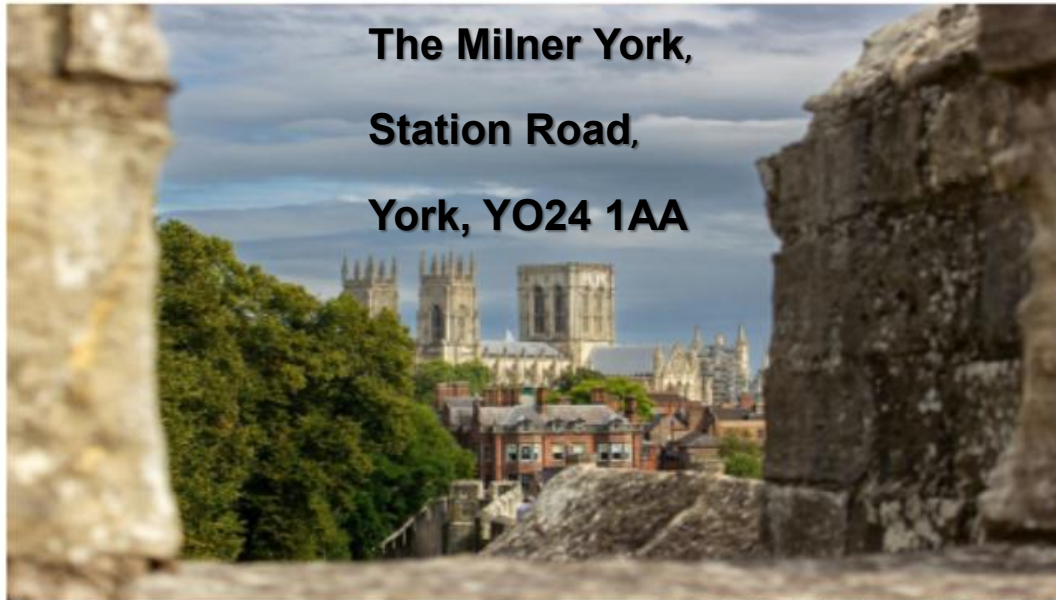
